

## The Back Cover Blurb

Sophia is 26, out of work, out of luck, and out of treatment plans for her hodgepodge of autoimmune diseases. With no way to support herself, she's feeling pretty hopeless... until she's gifted an iPad.

Bored and bedridden, Sophia creates a parody of a *New Yorker* magazine cover that portrays her hometown, Hong Kong. Hopes aren't high when she posts the doodle on Instagram, but suddenly, demand is.

Exhibitions in torrential typhoons, creepy fans, an experimental intravenous drug, and a raging uproar from a mob of robot enthusiasts suddenly have Sophia playing out an unexpected new life as an artist.

However, as dwindling Covid-19 restrictions, demands from new clients, and a deadline to move out loom, the sustainability of this new art career flies up into the air. Whether or not Sophia can juggle illnesses she never planned on having with a business she never planned on starting is anyone's guess.

### A BIT ABOUT THE AUTHOR

Sophia Hotung is a Eurasian Hong Kong native, writer, illustrator, and chronic illness speaker, best known for creating *The Hong Konger* art collection while bedridden from autoimmune diseases.

Sophia is an alumna of Lingnan Kindergarten, the Canadian International School, and Harrow International School in Hong Kong. She holds a BA in English from Barnard College in New York, and worked in corporate roles before her creative career pivot.

Sophia was awarded the South China Morning Post's Spirit of Hong Kong Culture award, is a member of Tatler Asia's Gen.T Leaders of Tomorrow, and is a two-time finalist (and two-time loser) of Hong Kong's American Chamber of Commerce's Women of Influence: Young Changemaker award. She will be speaking onstage about disability at this year's TEDxTinHauWomen event at Xi Qu Centre.

Sophia regularly gives her popular talk, Failure Club, at schools across Hong Kong. The workshop aims to help Hong Kong students reframe notions of success and adopt healthier perspectives on failure. *The (Unlikely) Hong Konger* touches upon these themes and more.

## WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN ORGANISING A TALK



#### 1. Convey any objectives you may have

Over email or a video call, we can discuss how my author visit can complement or support curriculum or themes that your students are currently focusing on. We can also discuss learning objectives that you would like me to address during the talk(s). For instance, some educators would like me to emphasise the importance of extracurricular reading, while others ask me to discuss handling failure in the build-up to receiving exam results.

#### 2. Schedule a time and handle logistics

We'll agree on a time for me to speak in-person or online, as well as a quotation (rates are available on the following page). Should you need documentation such as my Hong Kong ID card or any forms signed, I will revert swiftly with the requisite information.

Availability • I'm available from Nov 4 to Dec 9 and throughout March for on-campus visits and any date for online visits


Rates • HK\$1,000 flat fee, plus HK\$1,000 for every hour spent on campus. Fees are not affected by group sizes

**Duration of talks •** Workshops and talks can be adjusted to suit your school's schedule and class time durations. They typically run from 30 to 60 minutes

**Group sizes** • Interactive workshop formats are best for groups of 30 or fewer. Assembly formats are best for larger groups. We can also mix and match, starting with a whole assembly, then breaking into smaller groups

Ages • The (Unlikely) Hong Konger is geared towards readers aged 13 and up. I also offer workshops and have books suitable for ages 3 and up. Please visit sophiahotung.com/schooltalks for details

Miscellaneous • I'm happy to join students for lunch, breaks, after-school sessions, club meetings, or other events during my visit. (I bring my own lunch to accommodate my celiac disease, so no worries about providing food)
